AJL Release Schedule

The final AJL release will be installed in Kansas in either February or March, next the hosted states of Oklahoma and Delaware and then CDs will be mailed to the remaining states. There will be no more releases except for Federal mandates, a critical bug, or if there absolutely is not a work around for a problem. All other enhancement requests will be referred to redesign.

Enhancement Review

Seven enhancement requests were reviewed. Four will be incorporated into redesign, two will be done now, and one was rejected.

Job & Resume Searches

Shawn gave us a review of job and resume searches in redesign. The system uses information from the Census Bureau. All towns and job orders are given a latitude and longitude. Job orders located within a circle around the town and a map of the area will be displayed to the screen using a default date sort of the most recent on top. The fields for job search are "what" (job title or skill), and "where" (city or state or zip). You may select a distance radius and whether you want to include jobs from other job banks.

Staff will be able to push these features into the current AJL version by June or July. You will need to upgrade each server that you are currently using to Cold Fusion version 8 at a cost of approximately \$500.00 per server. You are probably using version 7 currently. You must have version 8 installed and running earlier than June or July.

TRAC (trac.ajla.net)

Shawn gave us a review TRAC. It is a ticket and WIKI system that will store the documentation of the history of AJL. The WIKI will become the user guide. Committee members and staff can review and add tickets. Each committee member has a user name and password, and staff will find out if one user name and password for "read only" can be issued for users in the field. If you enter your name on a ticket, you will get all future e-mails regarding that ticket.
