America's Job Link Alliance is pleased to introduce FiscalLink, the newest addition to America's JobLink. With FiscalLink, JobLink now provides local area and state program operators with the ability to manage fiscal operations for WIA including NEG programs, Welfare to Work, and TAA.

The FiscalLink Fiscal Management module is fully integrated with the ServiceLink One-Stop Case Management module. This integration allows each activity associated with a participant's service and training plan to have an individual budget to track participant expenditure and service provider payments.

FiscalLink allows users to fully track obligations and expenditures by funding source, program year, or fiscal year. FiscalLink provides real-time information on individual and overall participant obligations and expenditures by producing reports at the following levels for managers and staff: participant, vendor, office, local area, and state.

FiscalLink highlights include the ability for program operators to:

- Manage participant activity budgets.
- Process payments directly to participants for work experience wages, needs related payments, and supportive services such as child care and transportation.
- Link Participant budgets to vendors for processing vendor payments.
- Track payments to training and service providers by subcategories such as tuition, fees, books, and supplies.
- Create detailed expenditure records for participant activities.
- Generate vouchers for controlling participant and vendor payments.
- Generate standard delimited files for import into a check writing system.
- Import information generated by outside fiscal management systems to produce consolidated reports.
- Manage budgets and payments for Local Workforce Investment Board administration, including travel and conferences.
- Manage contracts-for-service budgets and payments for subcontractors, One-Stop operators, and training providers.
